- To not retain your information longer than necessary and ensure that it is securely disposed of at the end of the appropriate retention period
- To observe the rights granted to you under all applicable privacy and data protection laws, and promptly and transparently deal with queries relating to privacy issues
- To put security measures in place to protect your information

Dr Mark Papworth aims to be clear and transparent in regard to consent around data collection and data sharing. Clients are required to sign a detailed consent form prior to treatment commencing. Data will be shared with third parties where it is a legal requirement for this to occur. The other circumstances regarding the sharing of information are detailed in the consent form (circumstances associated with risk to self and/or others, clinical supervision, psychologist incapacity or death, as well as correspondence with other health professionals and referrers). Data kept on paper will be made inaccessible to unauthorised personnel. Data stored electronically will be password protected and held on encrypted external drives. No personally identifiable data is uploaded to cloud computing services. All data (paper and electronic) will be held for eight years and destroyed after that point, as per the usual requirement of professional bodies and insurers.

All individuals have a legal right to access their personal information that is held by Dr Mark Papworth.
